Michèl Willemsen (1968) was trained as pediatrician and pediatric neurologist in The Netherlands (registration 01-Jan-2000, BIG 69041355201), where he lives with his wife and three children. Actually, he works as a pediatric neurologist at the department of Pediatric Neurology of Amalia Children's Hospital at the Radboud University Medical Center in Nijmegen (The Netherlands). He is involved in patient care (especially children with movement disorders, neurometabolic or neurodegenerative disorders) and academic teaching including contributions to national and international courses and research. His focus is on GLUT1 deficiency syndrome, Ataxia Telangiectasia, Sjögren-Larsson syndrome, and neurotransmitter biosynthesis defects. Research is embedded in the Donders Institute for Brain, Cognition and Behavior in Nijmegen. He (co)authored > 240 scientific papers (Pubmed, October 2022). He is member of the board of the European Pediatric Neurology Society (EPNS), and member of many other (inter)national societies on Pediatrics, Neurology and inborn errors of metabolism. He was former member of the board of the Dutch Society of Pediatric Neurology, and the board of the International Child Neurology Association (ICNA). In the Radboud university medical center, he chairs the department of Pediatric Neurology since January 2008; he was acting head of the department of Neurology from September 2013 to June 2015, and is head of the department of Pediatrics since January 2019. He was appointed professor of Pediatric Neurology in February 2012.
