Anastasia Male-Dressler works at the Medical University of Vienna with a scientific focus on ketogenic diet therapies in childhood, paediatric epileptology, genetic syndromes, and developmental delay.



She completed her training in Child Neurology and Child Psychiatry at the University of Pisa's Stella Maris Institute and in the Department of Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine at the Medical University of Vienna. She holds various certificates, including EEG Diploma and Austrian Certificate Epileptology Plus. Prof. Male-Dressler has also authored and co-authored numerous articles and book chapters in her field of expertise, in particular on the ketogenic diet. In 2021, she was appointed as Associated Professor of Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine in Vienna
